# PATH ASSISTANCE

## *Eligibility*

- Must be enrolled in a Nursing or Allied Health Program
- Must be in-district
- Low income (receiving federal aid, such as SNAP, Medicaid, or TANF)
- First generation college student
- Minority or underrepresented student population
- Incumbent worker

## *Apply*

To receive assistance from Path, you must first complete a Path application, meet with the Path Support Coordinator, and provide any additional information including: documentation verifying eligibility (Financial Aid award letter, PELL grant information), current class schedule, and current booklist or supply list.

## *Benefits*

Path Student Support can assist with:

- Childcare Assistance
- Additional Resources as needed
